

How To Read A Bus Timetable

Reading a bus timetable is not always easy as there is often a lot of information which can sometimes be confusing. However, if you follow our easy guide you will find reading a timetable much easier.

Firstly, choose your start point as indicated by the red arrow. In this example, we have chosen Telford Town Centre Bus Station Departing towards the Princess Royal Hospital.

Secondly if you wish to depart from the Town Centre at 0800 follow the times down the timetable until you come to the Princess Royal Hospital, as indicated by the Blue Arrow.

In this example, the number 4 bus would arrive at the Princess Royal Hospital at 0836.

Not all timetables are as straight forward to read as our example, so please be aware of codes which some

operators timetables use to identify anomalies in timing points such as services operating on “schooldays” and “non-schooldays” as well as some services operating on “Saturdays” or “not Saturdays”. Some timetables use number codes to identify these anomalies so please ensure that you familiarize yourself with these codes.
